Loving and honoring Rasulallah (s) means that one should study his hadith and use them everyday.

Hadith on Fasting

Narrated Abu Huraira: The Prophet said, "Whoever fasted the month of Ramadan out of sincere Faith (i.e. belief) and hoping for a reward from Allah, then all his past sins will be forgiven, and whoever stood for the prayers in the night of Qadr out of sincere Faith and hoping for a reward from Allah, then all his previous sins will be forgiven." (Sahi Bukhari)

Hadith on Character

"The best among you are those who have the best manners and character."
(Sahi Bukhari)

Hadith on Quran

"Study Qur'an (regularly) for it will act as an intercessor and entreat for its readers on the Day of Judgment." (Sahi Muslim)

"The most superior among you (Muslims) are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it." (Sahi Bukhari)

Hadith on Giving

"Do not withhold your wealth, (for if you do so), God will withhold His blessing from you."
(Bukhari)

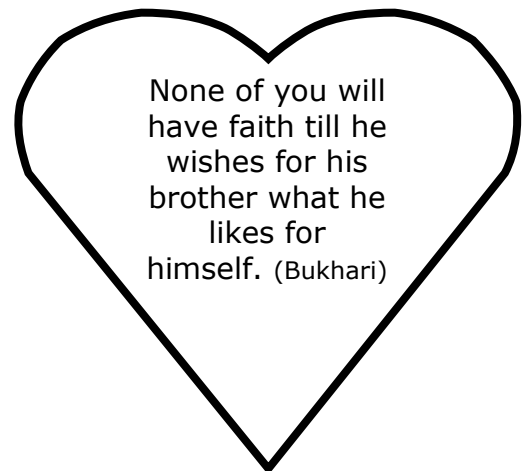
Hadith on Major Sins

Abdullah ibn Amr related that the Messenger of Allah said: "The major sins are to believe that Allah has partners, to disobey one's parents, to commit murder, and to bear false witness."
(Bukhari, Muslim)

Hadith on Character

"One who covers up the failings of somebody in this world, will have his shortcomings covered up by God on the Day of Judgment." (Muslim)

"Do not rejoice over the troubles of your brother, lest God might have mercy on him and involve you in this trouble." (Tirmizi)
